

<p>Day 1 - KYOTO</p> <p>Travel from Kuala Lumpur to Osaka (Kansai Int Airport). Depart at 1:00AM Arrived at 8:25AM.</p> <p>Take city train from Kansai to Osaka City. In Osaka, we only spent time for shopping and eating.</p> <p>Take train from Osaka to Kyoto, journey about 30 mins. The train stops at Kyoto Station then walk to Hotel about 15mins. <p>Day 2</p> <p>In the morning, take train to the famous Fushimi Inari Shrine. The Shrine located at Inari Train station, after get off from the station, you will see the red huge gate lead to the entrance. Suggested tour the place is 2-3 hours.</p> <p>In the afternoon, we heading to Bamboo Forest located at Arashiyama area. Take train from Inari to Saga-Arashiyama station (inter-change at Kyoto station, track no32 sagano line). From train station, walk to Bamboo Forest about 750m approx. 10mins. Suggested tour is 1-2 hour.</p> <p>We take train back to Kyoto Station then ride a city bus no 100 to Shijo Kawaramachi. Initial plan is going to Kiyomizudera Temple, since we realized we're late. The temple is closed at 5pm so we detour to Kawaramachi street via train from Kiyomizu-gojo to Sanjo.</p> <p>Kawaramachi is crowded with many visitors and shoppers, all taking in the many department stores and shops that line the streets in this main area of Kawaramachi dori in central Kyoto. The street run north to south, and this is considered the premier center of Kyoto, focused around Shijo Dori. <p>Day 3 – FURANO, Hokkaido.</p> <p>Wake up early morning to catch train to Kansai Airport. Today we travel to Hokkaido. Train journey about 1H36M. We depart by Jetstar Japan at 9:40AM and arrive at 11:30AM.</p> <p>Plane arrives at New Chitose Airport, Sapporo (gateway to Hokkaido). We straight go to Train ticketing counter to purchase train ticket to Furano Ski resort where we stay for 3 nights. Train journey is almost 3 hours and interchange at Asahikawa Station.</p> <p>Arrive Furano Station at 5pm. We missed shuttle bus to Ski resort then we take taxi straight to Guesthouse. Today, we want to explore Biei, the countryside where it's famous with Lavender farm during spring season. Since my visit is during winter, the farm was covered with thick snow. We take Lavender Bus at Kisen bustop (near our stay) to Biei Station then change to Biei Sightseeing bus to reach Shirogane. Shirogane has 2 things to see and do, Hot Spring and Blue Pond. <p>Day 7 – OTARU, Hokkaido.</p> <p>Take train from Sapporo Station to Otaru, journey about 30 mins. Otaru is a small harbor city, about half an hour northwest of Sapporo by train. Its beautifully preserved canal area and interesting herring mansions make Otaru a pleasant day trip from Sapporo. After spent half day at Otaru, we take train back to Sapporo and pick up our luggage then take train to New chitose Airport for flight to Tokyo.</p> <p>Take flight via Jetstar japan at 8:05pm and arrives 9:45pm. Day 8 – Tokyo

Today's itinerary is to explore Akihabara, Euno Ameyoko market, Nippori, Shinjuku and Shibuya. To reach those places easily take city train.

Akihabara also called Akiba after a former local shrine is a district in central Tokyo that is famous for its many electronics shops. In more recent years, Akihabara has gained recognition as the center of Japan's otaku (diehard fan) culture, and many shops and establishments devoted to anime and manga are now dispersed among the electronic stores in the district. Then we walk about 15mins to Ameyoko.

Ameyoko is a busy market street along the Yamanote line tracks between Okachimachi and Ueno Stations. The name "Ameyoko" is a short form for "Ameya Yokocho" (candy store alley), as candies were traditionally sold there.

Today, various products such as clothes, bags, cosmetics, fresh fish, dried food and spices are sold along Ameyoko.

Opening hours and closing days depend on individual stores, but stores typically open around 10:00 and close around 19:00. Many stores remain closed on selected Wednesdays.

Nippori, or Nippori Sen-i gai, is known as the fabric district of Tokyo. Located in the northeast part of the city, Nippori is easily accessed by the JR Yamanote line and is a great place to go if you want to spend a day shopping for fabric.

Shinjuku Station is the world's busiest railway station, handling more than two million passengers every day. About a dozen railway and subway lines, including the JR Yamanote Line, serve it. Shinjuku is also one of Tokyo's major stops for long-distance highway buses and city buses. Northeast of the station lies Kabukicho, Japan's largest and wildest red light district, while department stores, subterranean malls and electronic shops surround Shinjuku Station on all four sides, including the recently redeveloped Southern Terrace. We plan to enjoy The Robot Restaurant but the entrance fee is too expensive, about YEN5000 per person. We decided not to go and we had dinner at Shirokiya restaurant at one of district there.

Shibuya. A prominent landmark of Shibuya is the large intersection in front of the station's Hachiko Exit. The

<p>Day 9</p> <p>Last day in Tokyo we decide to explore Tsukiji Market and Ginza Shopping District. We checkout from hotel and bring our luggage to Tokyo Station. We store the big luggage at locker for 3 days at Tokyo train station. Take train to Tsukiji station then walk about 5 mins.</p> <p>Tsukiji Market (Tsukiji Shijō) is a large wholesale market for fish, fruits and vegetables in central Tokyo. It is the most famous of over ten wholesale markets that handle the distribution of fish, meat, produce and flowers in metropolitan Tokyo. Instead of visiting the inner market, tourists are encouraged to visit Tsukiji's outer market, which is located just adjacent to the inner market and caters to the public. The outer market consists of a few blocks of small retail shops and restaurants crowded along narrow lanes. Here you can find all sorts of food related goods, knives and fresh seafood and produce for sale in smaller (than wholesale) portions.</p> <p>We had lunch and snack at Tsukiji outer market area. Spent about few hours then we walk down to Ginza District.</p> <p>The Ginza is Tokyo's most famous upmarket shopping, dining and entertainment district, featuring numerous department stores, boutiques, art galleries, restaurants, nightclubs and cafes. Most shops in the Ginza district are open every day of the week. A visit is most pleasant on weekend afternoons when the central Chuo Dori street is closed to automobile traffic and become a large pedestrian zone. The road closure takes place from 12:00 to 17:00 (until 18:00 from April through September).</p> <p>In evening, we catch a night bus to Fujikawaguchiko, our next destination. Journey about 3 hours with 1 quick stop.</p> <p>We arrives at Kawaguchiko station around 10:40pm. The unlimited bus ride is covered 2 lakes sightseeing, Lake Kawaguchi and lake Saiko. Take the ride info of the route at the info desk. <p>Day 11</p> <p>Last day in Fuji, we take early breakfast in room and catch early sightseeing bus at 9am. This time we take Lake kawaguchi bus to take Mt Fuji reflection moment. Stop at no19, Sannide mae Nagasaki Koen Iriguchi to get the best view of Fujisan. At Noon, we had lunch at chinese restaurant before continue visit a lava cave. In the past, this cave was used as a natural storehouse and refrigerator, as the temperature inside stays at a relatively constant zero degrees Celsius throughout the year. The cave is furnished with a few shelves that store boxes of acorns and silkworm cocoons. We take bus express back to Tokyo at 5pm after spends last few hours at Lake Saiko. We reached Tokyo around 8pm then fetch the luggage at locker room and straight go to Chiba by train (30mins).
